Kaikukortti

What is Kaikukortti?

The Kaikukortti card can be used to get free tickets to, for example, festivals, concerts, dance performances or the theatre or to pay for adult education centre courses.

"Kaikukortti made it possible for me to come to Kuhmo to listen to chamber music in the first place. – Visiting Kuhmo was the high point of this summer."

For whom?

One is eligible for Kaikukortti, they are a client of an social service or healthcare actor that is a member of the Kaikukortti network. Kaikukortti is meant for young people, adults and families who cannot afford tickets or courses due to financial constraints.

Why Kaikukortti?

Culture is the basic right of everyone, also of people who have low income.
